Introduction

Kohltech international Limited (Kohltech) designs and manufactures high quality and energy efficient windows and entrance systems. At Kohltech, our vision is to be North America's most respected window and door company. To be a brand employees want to work for, dealers want to represent, and customers want in their homes.

The Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act (the "Act") requires that businesses state actions they have taken during the fiscal year to prevent and reduce the risk of forced labour or child labour within their operations and supply chain. This is the report for Kohltech International Limited, which has an obligation to publish a report under the Act. This report covers the fiscal year ended December 31, 2025.

Steps Taken to Prevent and Reduce Risks of Forced Labour and Child Labour

Kohltech continues to take action to prevent and reduce the risk of Forced Labour and Child labour within our supply chain. These actions include:

- Mapping of our supply chain
- Developing and implementing an action plan for addressing forced labour and/or child labour
- Developing and implementing due diligence policies and processes for identifying, addressing and prohibiting the use of forced labour and/or child labour in the organization's activities and supply chains
- Developing and implementing training and awareness materials on forced labour and child labour
- Engaging with supply chain partners on the issue of addressing forced labour and child labour

Structure, Activities and Supply Chain

Structure

Kohltech is one of Canada's largest window and door manufacturers, with its head office in Debert, Nova Scotia. Our manufacturing facilities are located in Debert, Nova Scotia; Edmonton, Alberta; and North Bay, Ontario.

Activities and Supply Chain

From an operational perspective Kohltech manufactures windows and entrance systems used in the residential and light commercial sectors. We distribute our products through a network of independent dealers who sell them to homeowners, builders and renovators throughout Canada and the Northeastern United States.

We rely on many suppliers for raw materials and indirect goods and services. Our supply chain involves purchasing a broad range of goods and services, from North American sources and we are in the process of further tracing our supply chain.

We are deeply committed to the highest standards of respect and integrity in our business relationships and activities. These standards apply within our organization and are also expected of our suppliers.

Policies and Due Diligence Processes in Relation to Forced Labour and Child Labour

We believe that good management is the essential foundation of a respectful and inclusive corporate culture that earns trust and builds value for all our stakeholders. We also recognize that respecting human rights is a shared responsibility of all enterprises regardless of where they operate globally. This perspective aligns with our Purpose, Mission, Core Values and Creed.

Through our Supply Chain Due Diligence program, we strive to ensure that products and services that are procured by us are fairly and ethically sourced and that forced labor and child labour are not present in our supply chains.

Having a robust approach for evaluating and verifying supplier human rights practices and performance will:

- effectively prevent and mitigate risks and harms to workers in Kohltech's supply chain
- help ensure compliance with all applicable human rights laws, regulatory requirements, and customer requirements, including those addressing forced labour and child labour
- provide transparency for customers, partners, the public, and other stakeholders
- ensure Kohltech's Supplier Code of Conduct requirements are upheld
- protect Kohltech's brand and reputation

This supply chain due diligence program applies to all Kohltech business activities and provides the framework to verify that suppliers are conforming to both our Supplier Code of Conduct standards and applicable legal requirements.

Risk of Forced Labour or Child Labour Being Used and The Steps Taken to Assess and Manage Risk

Kohltech recognizes the importance of risk assessment to identify and mitigate the risks of forced labour and child labour in its operations and supply chain. This risk assessment is a key element of the company's commitment to promoting ethical and responsible business practices. This assessment takes into account:

- Type of product, raw material, labour, or service
- Supplier location(s), both headquarters and operations
- Source countries of goods and raw materials
- Worker Origin countries

To date, Kohltech has not identified any risks of forced labour or child labour directly with its suppliers.

Measures Taken to Remediate Any Forced Labour or Child Labour Occurrences Identified

To date there have been no identified or reported instances of forced labour or child labour in our activities and supply chain.

Kohltech recognizes that to reduce and prevent the risk of forced labour and child labour within our operations and supply chain, we must assess the effectiveness of our actions. We are committed to doing this by regularly reviewing/auditing our policies and procedures related to forced labour and child labour.


Conclusion
